Apply for funding from the Ottawa Rural Clean Water Grants Program

The Ottawa Rural Clean Water Grants Program (ORCWGP) provides grants to projects that protect groundwater and surface water in rural areas.

Landowners completing projects in 2015 may be eligible for grants of up to \$15,000 depending on the project they are undertaking. **The next application deadline is October 15, 2015.**

Examples of eligible projects include:

- Buffer strips
- Livestock restrictions from watercourses
- Manure storage
- Land retirement
- Stream bank stabilization
- Tile outlet protection
- Tile drain control structures
- Well decommissioning

Funding is also available to decommission wells within the city's urban boundary.

Farmers from rural and urban Ottawa and landowners within rural Ottawa are eligible to apply. Approved applicants must have completed a third edition Environmental Farm Plan (farm projects) or Healthy Home Guidebook (non-farm projects).

Applications will be accepted through the LandOwner Resource Centre, which works in partnership with the Mississippi Valley, Rideau Valley, and South Nation Conservation Authorities, and the City of Ottawa.

Green Acres - Ottawa's Rural Reforestation Program

The City of Ottawa's Green Acres Program is looking for empty idle fields to be transformed into thriving green woodlands. The program provides landowners with advice and assistance in setting up a proper planting plan for their property (or properties).

Landowners must be rural property owners in the City of Ottawa, have a minimum of 0.4 hectares (1 acre) of suitable land and must agree to cover the subsidized cost of the tree seedlings, site preparation, planting and tending as well as agreeing to reasonably protect the plantation. The Green Acres Program will provide landowners with:

- Subsided tree seedlings;
- Advice and assistance in setting up a proper planting plan; and
- Assistance caring for the trees after they are planted.

The funding is provided to a maximum of 50% on a cost shared basis. Applicants must contact the LandOwner Resource Centre to verify that the proposed project is located in the eligible area and meets the funding guidelines.

Ontario Offering Grants to Help Protect the Great Lakes

Applications Now Open to Local Environmental Stewards Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change

Ontario is calling on community groups to help protect, restore and enhance the Great Lakes by applying for a Great Lakes Guardian Community Fund grant.

Now in its fourth year, the fund provides a grant of up to \$25,000 to not-for-profit organizations, schools, First Nations and Métis communities and other local groups for projects that have a direct environmental benefit to the Great Lakes. Past projects and activities supported by the fund have included:

- Planting trees
- Creating rain gardens
- Restoring wetland habitat
- Controlling invasive species
- Cleaning up beaches or shorelines
- Naturalizing stream banks and shorelines.

Applications will be accepted until October 23, 2015. (Note: Ottawa River and connecting channels and watersheds are eligible.)
