Weekly Rural Shoppers Bus Service

OC Transpo Route 202 provides free Tuesday only bus service from rural communities to urban shopping destinations (Orleans Shopping Center, Gloucester Center, St-Laurent Shopping Center). This route arrives at urban shopping centres around 10 a.m. and departs at 2:30 p.m. Buses are fully accessible and have space for two customers using wheelchairs.
